CHINESE SOCIETIES

The Chinese Society (Taiwan) of Soil and Fertilizer Sciences

The Chinese Society of Soil and Fertilizer Sciences is going to hold its 1991 annual meeting at Chen-Kung University, Tainan, Taiwan on December 13-15, 1991. There will be about 40 papers presented either orally or as posters. In addition, the invited speaker, the Vice-President of the ESAFS, Dr. Zhao Qiguo will present a special lecture in the meeting.

The Society has just finished a questionary survey of the comment and expectation from its member on the Society affairs. The statistics of the survey will be used as a guide for shaping up the Society.

Co-sponsored by the Society a special seminar on Soils and climate is scheduled to be held on August 13, 1991 at Taiwan Tea Experiment Station, Yangmei, Taoyuan, in commemoration of the retirement of Mr. Shin-Chuan Wong, a senior member of the Society and senior soil specialist of the Council of Agriculture.

Mr. Wong has dedicated about 40 years in research and administration of soil and fertilizer in Taiwan. He has greatly contributed to the land resource allocation on the Island.

Headed by Dr. T. C. Juang, a summer-visiting crew consisting mostly of the Society members has been formed intending to pay a visit to several key research organizations of soil science on mainland China. The visit will play an important role in information exchange between the two regions. It also symbolizes the mutual visit between the member societies.

KOREAN SOCIETY

Korean Society of Soil Science and Fertilizer

1991-General Conference was held at Yongnam Crop Experiment Station in Milyang on June 21-22 1991. The meeting approved the '91 budget about \$40,000. Professor Satoshi Matsumoto, Univ. of Tokyo was invited as a special iecturer in "Electrochemical Reclamation of Salts Affected Soils". In afternoon, 24 papers were presented, including soil genesis, physics, chemistry, microorganism, plant physiology and nutrition, and environment topics. The Scientist visited "Ice Valley" where the surface temperature is lower than 0 C during summer but it is warmer in winter.

The Society of co-sponsored a symposium on "Conservation of Environmental Resources in Sustainable Agriculture on July 3rd 1991".

Autumn meeting will be hold at International Technical Co-operation Center RDA in Suwon on Oct. 25 1991, with main topic of "Development of New Fertilizers and Quality controls for coming 2000s".

The Society has 630 individual members, 27 group members and 13 special members. The Journal of Korean Society of Soil Science and Fertilizer published quarterly.

Japanese Society of Soil Science and Plant Nutrition (JSSSPN)

The Japanese Society will hold its 1992 annual meeting as follows:

There will be both general presentation sessions for each of the 11 commissions (I-soil physics; II-soil chemistry; III-soil mineralogy and colloidal complexs, IV-soil biology; V-mineral nutrition; VI-plant metabolism; VII-Paddy soil fertility; VIII Upland soil fertility: IX-Boil genesis, classification and survey; X-fertilizer; XI-environmental protection) and several symposia sessions. The theme of the symposia are yet to be decided.

The Japanese Society has get up an ad hoc committee for discussing the culture plan of the society with Prof. M. Chino (The University of Tokyo) as its chairman. Restructuring of the commission system is one of the major subjects of discussion, so that the society can adapt itself to the development of modern science and technology in the related fields. The committee will submit its recommendations to the president of the society by the end of this fiscal year, i.e. March 1992.

An election of the new council members (fellows) of the society for 1992 - 1993 will be held in October this year. A total of 50 members will be elected on the regional membership basis, i.e. 4 from Hokkaido, 5 from Tohoku, 19 from Kanto, 6 from Chubu, 10 from Kansai, and 6 from Kyushu.
